## • Treasurer's Report (Maggie)

• Big events of November: Nothing Bundt Cakes and BINGO Night

## • Nothing Bundt Cakes:

- shows up on our treasurer's report as an expenditure due to the way the fundraiser was organized (money went through our bank account)
- We raised \$399 through the fundraiser
- BINGO Night:
  - Came in under budget
  - Overall raised just over \$200
  - Still no report on funds raised from BBQ truck (we should have more money coming in).
- Funds officially came in from the Read-A-Thon; we raised over \$10k
- Overall this year:
  - Spent \$12,664.58
  - Raised \$24,194.45
  - Originally "budgeted" for raising \$23,227.60
- Changes to the report are highlighted in yellow and show the following:
  - Student Enrichment programs will not cost us money. The \$250 expenditure was taken out.
  - Teacher Hospitality gifts we changed to a budget of \$1000 last PTO meeting.
  - NBC (explained above)
  - Official PTO Stationary: This was in our official budget since our first budget meeting in June, but somehow did not make the transfer to the reports. Money that had been put into Postage and Envelopes previously was switched to Stationery since that's what it was spent on. Money from paper/printing was switched into the postage/envelopes category since that was \$5.89 spent on envelopes.

- We will be re-visiting the annual budget to see where "extra" funds can be allocated. If PTO members have specific budget line items that they'd like to see more funds added to, please let us know!
  - Suggestion: recess equipment indoor and outdoor options
  - Suggestion: charter busses for field trip assistance
- Soliciting feedback in the spring for **Scholastic News**. This is the biggest PTO expenditure each year and we would like teacher feedback on Scholastic News needs paper, online versions, etc.

## Principal's Report (Mr. Meyer)

- Since our last meeting, the PTO supported Turkey Hunt for the staff with gift card prizes. It was a big success and a lot of fun for teachers and staff; thank you! Will also be using gift card prizes for staff Holiday Music Bingo (going on now), along with donations from other businesses.
- Bingo Night it was a huge success and lots of positive feedback. It was fun to have teachers and admin calling games and was a great way to bring the community together.
- Today was the first day for an on-staff Security Assistant at Cedar Point Ms. Palmira Cossio. We are thrilled to have her on board!
